Pre-registration by November 1 is required for all flights of the District Finals

**The qualifiers will be subsidized (\$700 each to 1st, \$500 to 2nd, \$300 to 3rd and \$200 to 4th) for travel expenses and hotel rooms. Order of qualification from the split sites will be posted on the web. ACBL dues or Life Master service fee must be current and continuous from the start of the District Final to the completion of the North American Pairs Final at the NABC in order to play in the National Final. Subsidies will only be given to pairs who play in the National Final.*

***NLM-eligible players may play in the Open or 0-2500 event on Saturday and in the NLM on Sunday if they don't qualify for the 2nd day.*
