



Baltimore COVID Policy

Objective: Provide a healthy environment for our bridge players, with as little inconvenience to players as possible

Summary: Everyone attending the tournament must be fully vaccinated, and mask wearing will be mandatory in the playing areas

Vaccination: All tournament attendees and staff must be fully vaccinated against Covid-19. "Fully Vaccinated" means that it has been at least two weeks since receiving the second Pfizer or Moderna shot, or receiving a single-dose CDC approved vaccine. If you are boosted, that is even better for you and everyone else!

Proof of Vaccination: You may show proof in two ways:

- 1) Pre-registration (Preferred) - email your Covid vaccination proof to the Safety Chair Georgette Weiss (georgetteweiss@hotmail.com) OR to Marty Bley tournament chair (campspringsduplicatebc@gmail.com.) Upon arrival at the bridge site, go to the VAX table and show ID to the volunteer. We will check you in and give you a bracelet to wear at all times at the site.
- 2) On site - If you have not pre-registered, bring proof to the tournament and show it at the VAX table along with an ID. Volunteers will be at these tables 60 minutes before game time each morning and can be found onsite if needed prior to the second session.

Please hold on to your bracelet. Each day just SHOW it to the volunteers as you enter the playing area. If you lose it, you must show proof again to get another bracelet.

Masks: Due to the high level of COVID infections at the recent Providence NABC, mask wearing will be mandatory in the playing areas. Masks may not be taken off in the playing areas other than sipping of liquids followed by immediate replacement of mask. Otherwise drinking and eating are not allowed. The break periods during each session will provide time for players to go outside and remove their masks, if necessary. Wear a well-fitting KN95 type mask- cloth masks will not be allowed.
