## Parking

Thanks to the continued generosity of player Rusty Krauss and his firm Janney Montgomery Scott LLC, we have teamed with the Hilton to provide FREE parking in the hotel garage as follows:

Commuters - keep your parking ticket with you. Find the PERSON of the DAY in the RED HAT or OTHER head wear - to put a sticker on your parking ticket. Per the Hilton, you will scan the front (showing the fee) and then the back of the ticket to exit at no cost to you.

Hotel Guests - hotel parking is automatically free for the first guest in each room. If a second guest arrives with a car, \$10 per night will be billed to the tournament.

NOTE that there are **no free** "in and out" privileges for commuters. If you choose to leave the garage during the day, you will have to pay yourself. If you have any questions, please contact the TC.

### **Partnerships**

Jim will help you make a match.

# Hospitality

These are the details for lunch, between the two sessions, Tuesday through Sunday. A concession stand will be available. During the first session of the day, you will receive a coupon good for Twelve Dollars worth of food from this concession stand for that day. The coupon will cover a sandwich or salad item plus chips plus tax. You pay for purchases that exceed \$12. NO CHANGE will be given if you purchase items at less than \$12.

The concession stand will be outside the playing area in the overpass between the hotel and the playing site. You may eat your meal at any place within the hotel space or outside if the weather is cooperative. PLEASE clean up your trash and place it in the proper type of receptacle.

The 3 or 4 choices for the various days will rotate between these items: Caprese Sandwich, Italian Sandwich, Mesclun Greens Salad, Superfood Salad, Veggie Chili, Chicken Tenders with Fries, Grilled Vegetables Sandwich, Smoked Turkey Sandwich, Spinach and Arugula Salad, Cucumber and Tomato Salad, Roast Beef Sandwich, Wild Mushroom Wrap, 50/50 Caesar Salad, Heirloom Tomato Burrata Salad, Maple Cured Ham Sandwich, Greek Salad Wrap, Mixed Greens Salad, Quinoa Salad, Greek Island Salad, and Panzanella Salad. There will also be chips, cookies, whole fruits, and candy bars available for purchase. A selection of soft drinks, coffee, and tea will also be available for purchase.

#### **ENTRIES**

Entry fees are \$20.00 per person per session. 0-20 MPs play free on Tuesday. CREDIT CARDS ONLY - NO CASH

PLEASE NOTE:

~Everyone using any kind of free play, discount, or prize coupon must pay \$4.00 per session. ~District 6 offers a \$5 discount to full-time students so, if applicable to you, email Shawn Stringer at <u>shstringer@aol.com</u> for details.

~Non-ACBL members must pay an additional fee of \$4.00 or they are welcome to join ACBL on the spot.

*Entry Express* is the online way to purchase entries designed by ACBL. You can use this program to reserve your seat and pay in advance. You can also cancel or change a registration. Once you have purchased your entry through Entry Express, when you arrive on site, you go to the designated computer to find your table assignment. This is a great way to avoid lines. Our link will not be activated until about August 1, so check the D6 website near that date to use *Entry Express*.

# **ZERO** Tolerance

The ACBL Zero Tolerance (ZT) Policy is in effect throughout the tournament. All players and participants are expected to behave in accordance with this policy at all times towards their partner, opponents, directors, caddies, tournament officials, and hotel staff. Call the director to handle any breaches of ZT, the rules, or code of ethics while in the playing area. Examples of commendable behavior under ZT include being a good host and guest at the table, calling "Director, PLEASE!" or "Caddie, PLEASE"; making sure all trash is removed from the table where you are sitting when the game is over. UNACCEPTABLE Behaviors include: Badgering, rudeness, intimidation, profanity, threats, or violence; negative comments about the opponents bidding or play; gratuitous lessons or analysis of partner or opponents play or bidding; gloating or whining about results; arguing with the directors; and last but not least a ringing, buzzing, noisy cell phone (full details below.) Recorder forms are available from a director to submit a record of unacceptable behavior.

**Electronic Device Policy:** The ACBL's electronic device policy allows players to bring cell phones into the playing area provided that such devices are kept in SILENT mode. Players may not use or interact with their devices while PLAY is



occurring at your table, including when dummy. When between rounds or sitting out, use is permitted provided it is inaudible. District 6 follows the policy set by the ACBL, and our directors will enforce the following penalties, at the respective form of scoring:
First offense: automatic disciplinary penalty of one-eighth of a board (or 1.5 IMPs) for a noise violation OR one-half board (6 IMPs) for a use violation.

Penalties are doubled for each subsequent offense.

➢ Kibitzers violating this policy will be removed from the playing area for the remainder of the session.

*"I didn't know" or "No announcement was made" is NOT a valid excuse or defense.* Any player with a potential emergency situation who needs to leave a phone turned on

must leave the phone with the Director.

# **Smoking and Scents Policy**

Smoking is absolutely prohibited in all locations inside the hotel and or playing area, including any rooms, restrooms, elevators and hallways. All smoking must be done at LEAST 25 feet from any building entrance (OR IN A Specific location if the site so designates.) Directors are authorized to assess penalties for lateness to any player who delays the start of a round or match due to a 'smoke break'. The Baltimore Regional is a fragrance free zone. Players MUST refrain from wearing any of the following: Cologne, aftershave lotion, perfume, perfumed hand lotion, fragranced hair products, and/or similar products when participating in our tournament. These fragrances can cause serious health issues for migraine suffers, and people with breathing related problems. Thank you for adhering to this policy! *Cliff notes - Bring your bridge sense but leave all other scents at home!*



# Upcoming District 6 Events

### District Six North American Pairs, Fall, 2023

It's time to be planning for the 2023 North American Pairs! This event will be conducted in the usual three flights: Flight A = Open; Flight B = 0-2500; Flight C = Non-LM (<500). Masterpoints are as of the June cycle, i.e., May 6, 2023.

Club qualification is required. Both face-to-face and online clubs may schedule NAP qualifying sessions during June, July, and August. Check with your favorite clubs now and make plans to attend these qualifying sessions, which pay higher-rated masterpoints that are 50% red.

The District 6 Grass Roots Committee is working hard to choose the best format for this premier local competition. The District Finals will be held in late September. Details, including preregistration deadlines, will be published on the District website shortly. The leading pairs in each flight will represent our District at the NABC in Louisville KY in March 2024.

### District Six Grand National Teams, Winter 2024

Only a little bit farther down the road is the 2023-2024 Grand National Teams! This event will be conducted in the usual four flights: Championship Flight = Open; Flight A = 0-6000; Flight B = 0-2500; Flight C = Non-LM (<500). Masterpoints are as of the September cycle, i.e., August 6, 2023.

The District level GNT competition will be held during the winter months of 2024. The details for each flight will be published on the District website shortly. The leading teams in each flight will represent our District at the NABC in Toronto ON in July 2024.
